

USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY

RED STAKES OR LINES - Lateral Hazard.

WHITE LINES - Ground Under Repair, Ball may be lifted, cleaned, and dropped, without penalty, within one club length of the nearest point of relief not nearer to hole.

YELLOW STAKES OR LINES - Water Hazard.

EMBEDDED BALL - Embedded ball rule in effect. Rule 25-2.

BICYCLE PATH - Behind 3 and 14 green and left of 15 - out of bounds.

LOCAL RULE: Relief must be taken from all landscaped areas on the golf course. The wood chips to the left of #15 are loose impediments and relief may not be taken from them.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Out of bounds at West Shore is defined by:

- White Stakes
- The inside edge of the bicycle path behind #3 and #14 greens, and to the left of #15
- The outside edge of the cart path behind #11 green.
- The inside edge of the top board on the first wall behind #12 green.
