JUNE GREENS UPDATE

1. LABOR UPDATE

- A. Holding steady at 15 employees, most of which are full time now.
- B. Most days we are using all of our available equipment and have to be strategic about job assignments due to limited cart availability.
- C. We have hired a new equipment manager, John Moynihan! He started on June 14th and has done a fantastic job so far.

2. GOLF COURSE UPDATE

- A. Plan to lower H.O.C in rough and increase frequency of mowing. Going down to 2.5" from 2.75". Previously we mowed 1x a week, now to be mowed 2x a week around greens and primary rough (30-40' adjacent each fairway) and still 1x a week in less played areas. I hope with increased staff these reputations can be maintained while necessary.
- B. Tees and Fairways will also see an increase in mowing repetitions when weather allows, again due to increase staff numbers.
- C. Irrigation problem on #1 is still not solved but I have been able to minimize problems now that I know more about them. Still working with Rainbird to resolve the situation.
- D. Pump house plans and quotes are underway but the old station is getting the job done when necessary.
- E. Heavy rains have exposed drainage inefficiencies and planning has begun to fix these areas, 5 and 16 approach for examples.
