WINTER GREENS UPDATE

- GOLF COURSE UPDATE

- The abnormally warm late fall allowed the maintenance team to accomplish some extra projects around the course including new drainage in several problem areas, converting some of #5 approach to low mow bentgrass and shortening #9 fairway.
- Our tree maintenance program is in full swing, we have cut back the perimeter growth on #16 and #17 to increase ascetics and playability as well as increase the turf health in these problem areas.
- Selective tree removal is in the works across the golf course, trees being removed are part of our master tree plan, or in poor health and a safety concern. Some transplanting of existing trees and new plantings will take place this spring.
- Controlled burn of the 'pit' as soon as weather is favorable.
