# APRIL GREENS UPDATE

## 1. LABOR UPDATE

- A. Out of five hopeful new hires only one remains. Lost employees' former jobs and unemployment benefits. Currently operating with a staff of 7 all basically part time.

## 2. GOLF COURSE UPDATE

- B. The intermediate rough or 'step cut' will be implemented this week.
- C. Stumps seeded and fertilized should hopefully start to see growth in the coming weeks.

## 3. PUMP STATION UPDATE

- A. Vince from Mid-Ohio Electric was down last week to tune up our pumps. Pump parameters were changed to make them work as efficiently as possible.
- B. Several recommendations were made for upgrades to the electrical infrastructure, and the overall system as a whole. (burying wire, 2 new switches in the short term, and new computer module long term.)
- C. Need to choose path going forward between band-aid fixes with Vince on a regular basis, or significant upgrade to ease future headaches and expenses.

## 4. HYDRALIC LEAK AROUND 7 GREEN

- A. New rough mower with 7 hours sprung a leak from a hydraulic fitting under the mower, several passes around 7 green were made before the operator realized. I do not anticipate any long-term damage but it may be unsightly for some weeks to come.

5. 12 TEE

- A. Use of a mat for a few weeks will hopefully preserve the tee for the golfing season.
