Mark Mercatante would like the board to consider a new by-law that would seek voting members approval to sell any WS property \$50,000 in value or more, similar to the by-law that requires voting members approval to purchase anything \$50,000 or more.

Jim Nelson informed the board that Grosse Ile will be replacing the city water main under the north bound lane of West River Rd from GI Parkway to Church starting in the spring of 2018. GI Township will also repave the north bound lane and the county will pay for repaving the south bound lane. More info to come from the township early in 2018.

- Pre-paying dues annual is beneficial to the Club, it allows us to pre-pay for supplies (fertilizer) and receive a 5% discount. Need to socialize this membership to increase annual payments.

Jan 2018 ended with a \$1,384 net profit.

Projection for Feb month end is a cash balance of approximately \$65,000.

The difference between member resignations and new members will result in a loss of \$45,000 in dues. WS will need to recruit at least 25 new members to offset this loss in dues.

Committee Reports:

Finance – Rick Robinson

Feb 2018 ended being \$2,175 in the red due to a \$3, 839 tax bill for the carts.

It is estimated that WS will have a deficit of \$80,000 at year end based on our current membership. As a result the board has approved an assessment of \$75 per month for 8 months. If we are able to recruit 10 new members then the assessment will be waived for December, if we are able to get 20 new members then the assessment will be waived for November and December, and if we are able to get 30 new members, then the assessment will be waived from October through December.

Just as a reminder, if a current member recruits a new member they will get a \$300 credit for each new member that they recruit.

Delinquent accounts came down to approximately \$13,600. Follow up letters were sent.

A DO NOT PLAY LIST will be sent to the Pro Shop every Monday for people that are delinquent.

The golf course should be open around April 1st depending on the weather, give or take a week or so.

The Ball in Hat Group

The Ball in Hat group (not a league) is an informal gathering of friends that meet at 10:00 week days Tuesday – Friday to play golf. Our group includes players of all handicaps (from 4 to 27), and we play the yellow and white tees at full handicap so everyone is competitive.

So here is how it works - *just show up before 10:00 am*, and drop a ball in the green hat. Then, depending on the number of players (we average 12 but have had as many as 24), the low handicappers draw balls from the hat to form teams of 3, 4, or sometimes 5.

The games we play vary from day-to-day, and depending on course conditions (i.e. wet) include:

- Normal golf and score 2 best balls
- Scramble the drive and score 2 best balls
- 3, 4, or 5 person full scramble
- Red white and blue - each team must hit 6 from each color tee
- Stapleford
- ETC... just a bit of variety to have fun.

We also have some special rules: The leaf rule, the root rule, and gimmies inside the leather (to be explained on site).

The “entry” cost is \$15, and we pay out lowest 2 best ball totals for front, back, and total. We pay CTP and Skins, and payouts are at full handicap. If there is an odd number of players, someone will play pins and skins only for a \$9 entry.

Anyone and everyone is welcome to join the Ball in Hat group.

For new members it is a great way to meet other members and have fun!

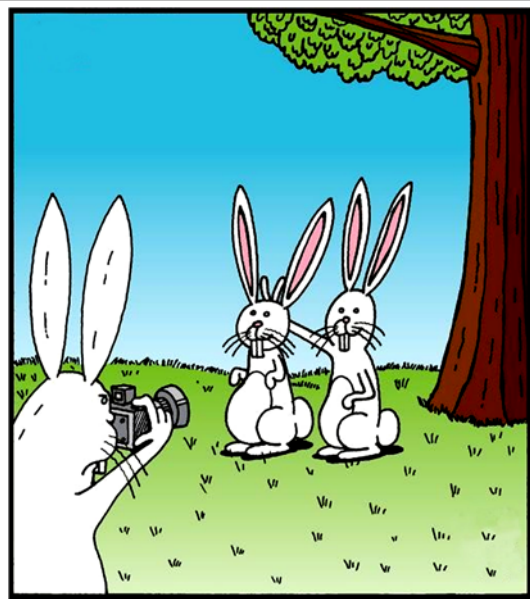

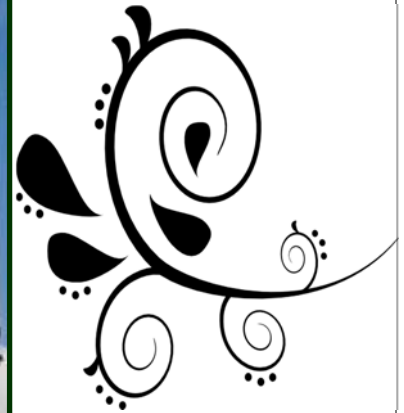

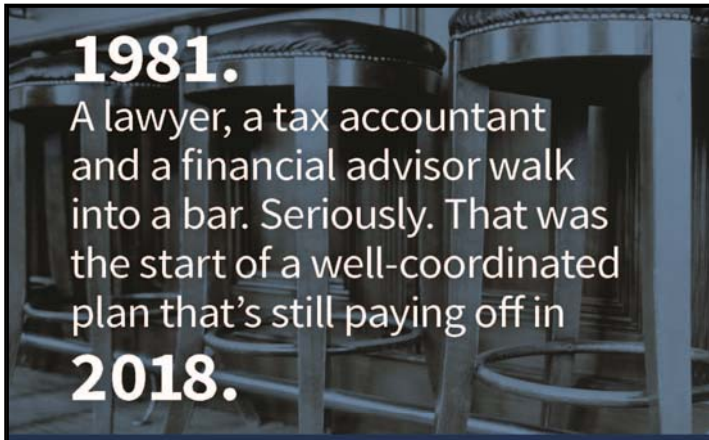
